Steps to completing OTSA:

1. Set a counseling appointment with the Transfer Counseling Center to ensure you are eligible to transfer in fall '12.
2. Sign up for an OTSA appointment in the Transfer Counseling Center.
3. Complete a CSU Admission Application online at least 48 hours in advance of your OTSA.

CROSS ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

This program is for current Butte students planning to transfer to CSU Chico. The program allows students to **enroll in one class at Chico State for FREE** while attending Butte College. Program requirements: must have completed English 2, demonstrated progress toward a transferable math class, and have completed a minimum of 30 transferable units with a 2.0 GPA, or higher. No former CSUC students, please. Students are eligible to participate in the program for up to two years, but **must re-apply each semester**. Come to the Transfer Counseling Center for more information and a Fall 2011 Cross Enrollment application for Spring 2012 classes. The deadline to apply is December 1st.

A Message From the Transfer Counseling Center Coordinator/Counselor...

The **Transfer Counseling Center (TCC)** is reinventing itself to better serve students through these difficult budget times. In order to serve more students the TCC will no longer be providing classroom presentations and will minimally reduce the number of individual appointments available to students. The TCC will strive to provide more direct services that support transfer initiatives and student transfers. We will place more emphasis on utilizing on-line technologies that do not require the student to be present via "Ask-A-Transfer-Counselor" workshops, that will provide both general information on transferring to a 4 year campus information related to transfer initiatives, such as completing an admissions application, cross enrollment, On-The-Spot-Admission, how to transfer into a competitive major, etc.

While being able to meet with students one-on-one can be the best part of our job, it is not always the most efficient use of our time with students. In the interest of trying to serve more students the TCC will introduce a series of workshops that will help us reach more students and reduce their need to make individual appointments to meet with a counselor. While we would rather meet with each of you individually, get to know you and your education goals, and map out a Student Education Plan, the current fiscal climate requires that we change the way we meet student demand for appointments.

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) for UCs

A TAG guarantees your admission to a participating UC campus. A TAG contract is written prior to the application filing date. We offer TAGs with UC Davis, UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Riverside, UC Santa Cruz, UC San Diego and UC Santa Barbara. To qualify for a TAG you must have at least 30 transferable units completed at the time you sign the TAG contract and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 to 3.5 (depending on your major). Impacted or highly competitive majors may require a higher GPA. Set a Transfer Counseling Center appointment today to find out if you meet the UC TAG requirements!

NOTE: If you already have an approved TAG, be sure to submit your admission application within the priority filing periods (see front) and get IGETC certified through the Transfer Counseling Center.

IGETC Certification

Students following the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) sheet may be required to submit a completed IGETC Certification prior to starting the first term at a 4-year college. The IGETC Certification is used to satisfy UC, CSU, and some private and out-of-state University Admission/GE requirements. IGETC Certifications are only completed in the Transfer Counseling Center. Once you have completed all areas on the IGETC sheet with a letter grade of "C" or better **POSTED** to your transcript, set an appointment with the Transfer Counseling Center to get your IGETC Certification!
